Are you truly Mission Minded?

Acts 1:8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Two questions for you: 1) Are you a missionary? 2)What is the greatest commandment?

Matthew 22:36-40 “Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?” [37] And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. [38] This is the great and first commandment. [39] And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. [40] On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets.”

Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. [19] Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, [20] teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

God’s purpose for the believers life is summed up in one sentence: Love God, Love others and share the Good News of salvation in Jesus...every chance you get?

Every believer is commanded to love God and love others and every believer is also commissioned to be a missionary - Missionary means one who is sent on a mission. And what is the believers mission? Acts 1:8-11 [8] But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

A missionary literally means one who is sent on a mission. Every christian is commissioned giving the mission of sharing the gospel this is for all believers not just a few. So how do you know if you’re truly mission minded?

- 1) You recognize your mission field. Where God has planted you right now.
- 2) You are going with the good news of salvation. Distance doesn’t matter the going does!
- 3) You understand that every command of God, every commission of God, every promise of God, has the INDWELLING LIFE OF JESUS as its power source. 2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory.
- 4) You understand its not about your skills but about heart condition. Skills aren’t necessary but a servants LOVING heart is mandatory.(cont.)

Thank you for your prayers and words of encouragement over the past couple of months as we made a quick trip to the USA for Jamie to have basal cell cancer removed from an ear. We had certainly not planned on a 3-week trip to the USA, but we can look back and see some definite blessings as a result. We feel like we are in much better place going forward than we would have been if we had made a different choice.



Jamie's ear is healing well, and he is hoping that he will not have to bandage it anymore in a couple of weeks. Although the dermatologist had to remove a fairly large spot due to the size of the skin cancer, the area is filling in well and may not be that noticeable in the future.

The kids enjoyed being with Grandma and cousins, swimming, fishing, watching fireworks on July 4th, going to stores, bowling, eating yummy food, taking a trip to an amusement park, and flying on airplanes.

We are currently in quarantine in our house in Ukarumpa PNG, as is required for all international arrivals. Once we are released, Jamie will go back to his role as a pilot supporting the work of Bible translation.

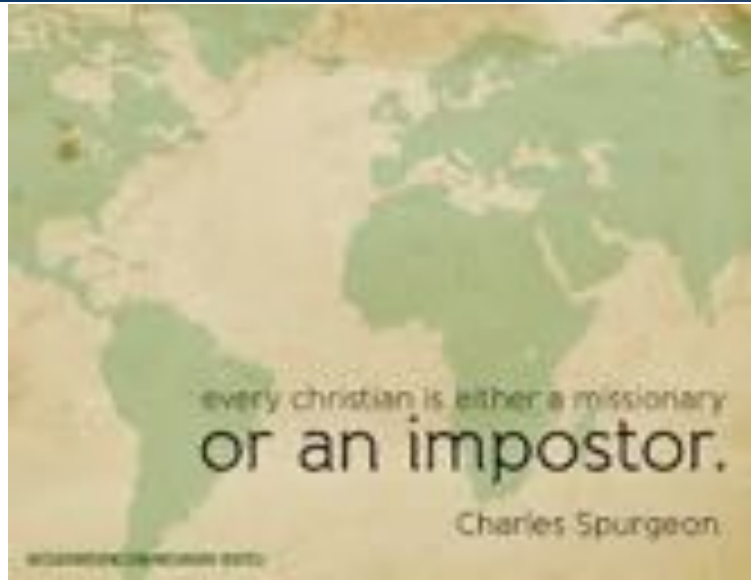
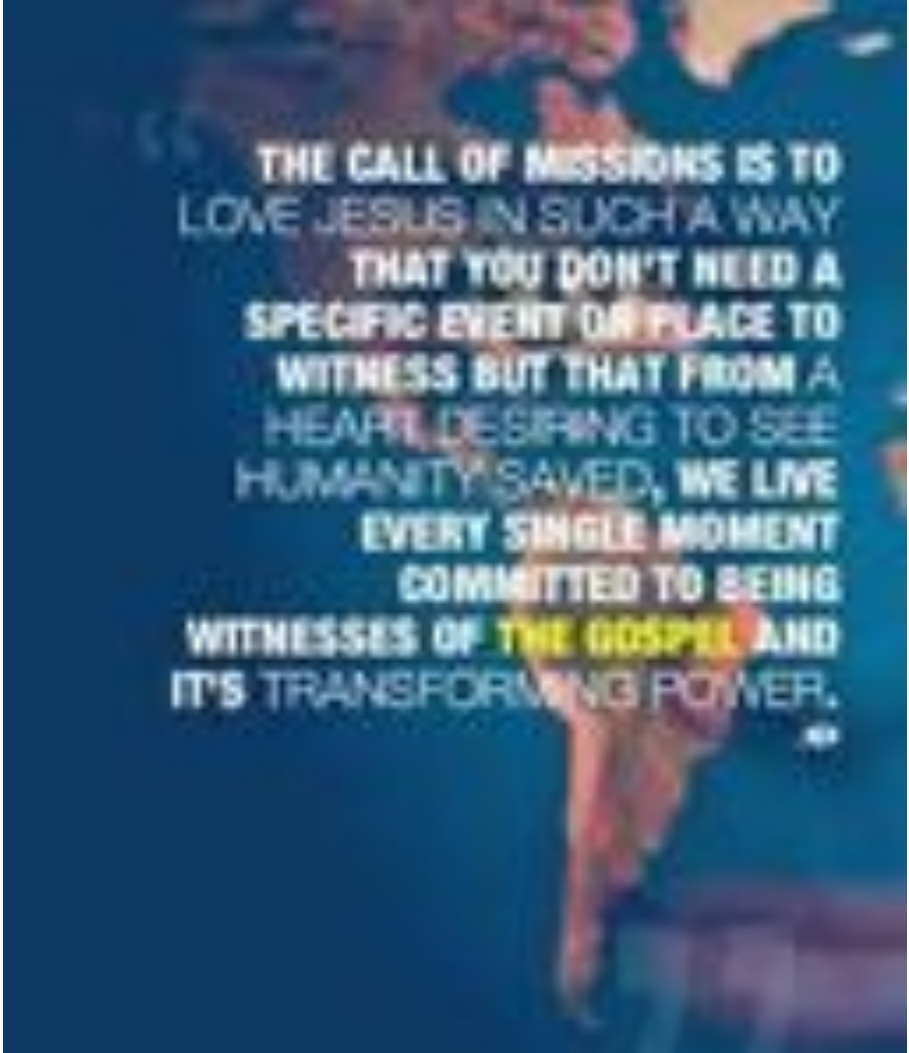

The past 3 months I have been training Udu and Beatrice to be flight coordinators for our aviation department. They have learned a lot about the mission community here in Ukarumpa and the work of Bible translation. They have also learned about how to use our flight booking program, and how to take people's requests and make them into actual flight bookings. I have to admit, it has been a challenging time to train flight coordinators as our flying has been limited due to covid restrictions. But the reverse would be true that if we were really busy flying, then I would be needed flying instead of training. I have made the best of it and, hopefully, Beatrice and Udu got enough training to be able to effectively fit the flight request puzzle together in the future.

My 3-month commitment to train Udu and Beatrice is now over, but I have been asked to spend another month training another flight coordinator/receptionist. So, I will continue on in my training role for now, and plan to return to flying in June.
